Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving net zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 956.08 tCO₂e by 2030. This is a reduction of 15%.

Carbon reduction projects

Completed carbon reduction initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2024 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to 625.06 tCO₂e, a 35.7% reduction against the 2024 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract.

We improved operational efficiency by implementing advanced route optimisation strategies, reducing delivery times and fuel consumption. Additionally, we introduced a new fleet of vehicles equipped with modern technology to enhance performance, safety, and sustainability. To further support our environmental goals, we reduced packaging materials across our operations, minimising waste and lowering our overall carbon footprint.

Future carbon reduction initiatives

In the future we hope to implement further measures:

We are actively exploring opportunities to transition to renewable energy sources, including green energy tariffs and on-site solar generation, to reduce our reliance on fossil fuels. In addition, we are engaging with suppliers to identify lower-carbon and locally sourced options that help reduce emissions across our supply chain. To support continuous improvement, we are also developing a structured approach to carbon tracking so we can measure our impact, set clear reduction targets, and monitor progress over time.

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 006 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
